Endorse: Identify and endorse women candidates in Ohio who share our beliefs and principles will work to achieve equality, influence, and power for all women in Ohio.

Encourage: Demystify the political arena, its systems, processes and roles, so that women understand - and leverage - the power of their participation.

Advocate: Strengthen women's political voices by supporting legislation and policies and uplifting the women who advocate for them.

You will have an opportunity to engage in specialized projects based on your skills and interests, in alignment with the needs and mission of the organization.

Duties may include, but are not limited to:

- Researching candidates who apply for Matriots endorsement.
- Engaging with Matriots candidates and their campaigns.
- Research on relevant current events across the state.
- Assisting with The Matriots candidate endorsement process.
- Locating state policies/legislation enacted by previously endorsed Matriots candidates to determine candidate impact.
- Event logistics support, including help with execution at events, tables, etc.
- Donor stewardship and data management support.
- If the intern has other skills related to policy, communications, marketing, writing, graphic design, social media, photography/videography, etc. - we will add duties as appropriate to leverage those skills.
